Recommended Equipment & Gear List

Dear Parents and Students:

Soon, your class will be visiting Hard Bargain Farm Environmental Education Campus! Here is a list of things that you will need for your trip. Some activities may involve wading in shallow water or mud, so footwear that can get wet and dirty is essential. During cold weather, pack plenty of warm clothes and if possible, waterproof boots (the farm does have some rubber boots). Several layers of clothing are usually warmer than wearing one heavy coat. Do not pack "dressy" clothes. To avoid loss, mark all personal items with the student's name and school.

BE SURE TO EAT A GOOD BREAKFAST the day of the field trip. WE WILL BE VERY ACTIVE and may not eat lunch until 12:30 or 1:00 PM.
