








TRASH TIMELINE

| Cardboard Box |  | 450 Years * |
| Tin Can |  | 450 Years * |
| Plastic Bag |  | 600 Years * |
| Plastic Bottle |  | Thousands to Millions of years |

* Although no one has lived for 450 or 600 years, many scientists believe plastics never entirely go away
